Future Funding Process – Revised August 2025

1. Purpose

To establish a transparent and consistent process for evaluating and approving funding requests from Royal College and its affiliated bodies, in accordance with the Association's constitutional objectives.

2. Guiding Principles

- **Alignment with Constitution:** All funding must support the educational, cultural, recreational, or welfare objectives of Royal College.
- **Transparency:** All requests and approvals must be documented and minuted.
- **Accountability:** Funding decisions and payments are subject to audit and inclusion in annual accounts.
- **Non-binding:** This policy provides guidance and does not restrict the decision-making autonomy of future Executive Committees.

3. Submission of Requests

Requests must be submitted using the official ORAUK Funding Request Form (June 2025). The form must include project details, budget, and authorisations from relevant Royal College authorities. Requests should be emailed to both president.orauk@gmail.com and secretary.orauk@gmail.com.

4. Evaluation and Approval

Funding requests will be reviewed at the next Executive Committee meeting. Decisions will be made by majority vote and recorded in the minutes. Priority will be given to projects that:

- Benefit a wide group of students
- Have long-term educational or welfare impact
- Uphold Royal values and traditions
- Demonstrate transparency and accountability.

5. Disbursement

Payments shall be made only after ExCo approval and Treasurer's confirmation of fund availability. All payments must be supported by documentation and noted in the Treasurer's report for inclusion in the annual audit.

6. Reporting

Recipients are expected to provide confirmation of project completion and a brief report or photographs. The Treasurer will maintain records of all approved funding.

7. Policy Review

This process may be reviewed and updated by future Executive Committees as needed to ensure compliance with the Constitution.
